UNIT 5 – Lessons for life

READING: video games in class – using linking words as clues – gapped text

GRAMMAR: defining and non-defining relative clauses – reduced relative clauses

VOCABULARY: learning skills and phrasal verbs – money – uncountable nouns

LISTENING: money management – predicting answers – multiple choice

USE OF ENGLISH: open cloze – multiple-choice cloze

SPEAKING (role-play): life skills – justifying your opinion – collaborative task

LISTENING: inventions inspired by nature - extracting key details - sentence completion

SPEAKING: science and technology - giving two sides to an answer - discussion

WRITING: film - dramatic present tenses - review

SWITCH ON: spider science - research-based presentation

UNIT 7 – Home and away

READING: alternative living spaces – using reference words – gapped text

GRAMMAR: conditionals (0/3) - wishes, preferences and regrets

VOCABULARY: living accommodation and furnishings - synonyms and antonyms - prepositions

LISTENING: learning languages – listening for positive or negative ideas and opinions – multiple matching

USE OF ENGLISH: key word transformation – multiple-choice cloze

SPEAKING: talking about yourself – giving information about yourself – interview

WRITING: description of a visit to a place – using appropriate informal register – informal email

SWITCH ON: homes for the future – plan a living space

UNIT 8 – What's in a number?
